

## 2018 – 2019 Dress Down Days

- October 31** – Black & Orange Dress (no costumes)  
**November 20** – Favorite Outfit (last day before break)  
**December 18 - 20** Christmas Colors/Sweater (Secret Santa, Christmas Crazy & Christmas Break  
 (hats/headbands may be worn while shopping at Secret Santa)  
**February 14** – Valentine’s Day Colors  
**March 15** – St. Patrick’s Day – Wear Green  
**April 16** – Favorite Outfit (Easter Break Begins)  
**June 5** – Favorite Outfit (Sunday Best) – Last Day School

### Dress Down Day – Dress Code

APPROPRIATE	NOT APPROPRIATE
Jeans or sweatpants	Spandex, yoga pants, pajama pants, pants with holes, and tight-fitting pants
Shorts may be worn during warmer weather <i>No shorter than 2” above the knee</i>	Short shorts, spandex, yoga shorts, holes, and tight-fitting shorts. <i>Short length must be the same length as the uniform shorts.</i>
Dresses or skirts <i>No shorter than 2” above the knee</i>	Short dresses and short skirts. <i>Dress/skirt length must be the same length as the uniform dress or skirt.</i>
Polo-style shirts, T-shirts, button shirts, sweaters, sports jerseys, or sweatshirts	Tank tops, sleeveless tops, strapless, offensive graphics and/or slogans
School shoes, sneakers, “Ugg”-style boots, and other flat shoes or boots	Sandals, flip-flops, cowboy-style boots, high-heels (greater than approx. ½ inch), open toe and/or open heels
Socks of any color/length	Offensive graphics or slogans
	Hats, masks, etc. (unless specified for the special occasion). Hair colors (red, blue, green, etc.)

Leggings: With the recent clothing trend of leggings (like LuLaRoe) being so popular, please note that students must wear a dress, skirt, or long tunic top over their leggings. The tunic top or shirt that is worn over a pair of leggings must come down PAST the child's fingertips when their arms are down at their sides.
